Romans 2:11	Who does not show favoritism? <i>God</i>
Romans 2:11	God does not show what? <i>Favoritism</i>
Romans 3:23	All have sinned and fall short of what? <i>The glory of God</i>
Romans 3:23	Who have sinned and fall short of the glory of God? <i>All</i>

Romans 4:5	Whose faith is credited as righteousness? <i>Their (the one who does not work but trusts God who justifies the ungodly)</i>
Romans 4:5	Who justifies the ungodly? <i>God</i>
Romans 4:5	God justifies whom? <i>The ungodly</i>
Romans 4:5	What is credited as righteousness? <i>Faith</i>
Romans 4:5	The one who trusts God who justifies the ungodly, their faith is credited as what? <i>Righteousness</i>
Romans 4:8	Who is blessed? <i>The one whose sin the Lord will never count against them</i>
Romans 4:8	The one whose sin will never count against them is what? <i>Blessed</i>
